

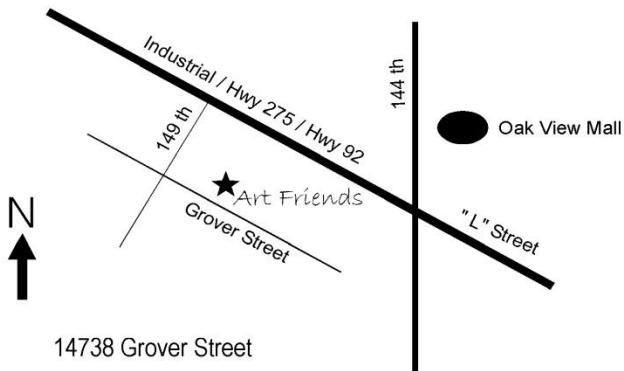
Directions to Art Friends
